Credentialing Examination Pass Rate (PR State Licensing Examination)

Is defined as the number of graduates who pass, on first attempt within six months of graduation, the credentialing examination or an unrestricted state licensing examination compared with the number of graduates who took the examination, during the five-year reporting period (JRCERT,2015).

2014	67%	2 of 3 students passed on 1 st attempt within six months of graduation.

Defined as the number of students who complete the program within 150% of the stated program length (JRCERT, 2015).
