### Faculty Analysis and Endorsement of Claims

#### Claims endorsed:

**Claim 1. Subject Matter Knowledge:** The candidates at completion<sup>1</sup> and completers<sup>2</sup> of the Educator Preparation Programs demonstrate knowledge in their subject matter or specialization by achieving a performance above the passing scores of standardized tests for certification, and 80% (“B”, above average attainment) in other measures.

**Claim 2. Pedagogical Knowledge:** The candidates at completion and completers of the Educator Preparation Programs demonstrate pedagogical/professional skills to apply them to an education context or level by achieving a performance above the passing scores of standardized test for certification, and 80% (above average attainment or satisfactory) or more in other measures.

**Claim 3. Research:** The candidates at completion and completers of the Educator Preparation Programs demonstrate that they have learned how to access information on their own (research), that they can transfer what they have learned to new situations, and that they have acquired the attitudes and skills that will support life-long learning in their field by achieving a performance of above average attainment/satisfactory or more.

**Claim 4: Technology:** The candidates at completion and completers of the Educator Preparation Programs are able to use technology in their education context or level by achieving performance of above average attainment/satisfactory or more.
