	· Enrolled full time (Full Timers) in their first FALL term.
	Once the cohorts were selected for each year of entry, follow-up was carried out over the next six academic years to determine how many of these students graduated from the Institution. The number of students who graduated was then divided by the base cohort and multiplied by one hundred to calculate the cumulative graduation rate. The six-year cumulative graduation rate reflects the percentage of students in the cohort who graduated in six years or less. The formula is as follows: % Graduation = (Number of graduates / Number of the cohort) X 100
